Embedd practice

Embedded librarianship

Embedded librarianship is not a new practice in academic librarianship. The collaboration between faculty and librarians may reach a level which librarians are embedded in the classroom to teach library instruction or integrate research assignment in to the course curriculum.

Interacting with patrons and fulfilling their information needs has been a core service in librarianship. This is particularly true for academic librarians, whose teaching role has evolved as an ever-greater component (Norelli, 2010). To increase understanding of user needs, librarians have been trying to engage their user groups by getting involved in the events or trying to engage their user groups by getting involved in the events or conferences from their users' area of specialization (Shumaker & Tally, 2009).

As a matter of fact, several articles define embedded librarianship as "the group seeking to integrate is experiencing and observing the daily life of the primary group' (Dewey, 2005, p.6). They can become a part of their users' culture by being physically present in their users' locations or through the use of advanced computer technologies (Drewes & Hoffman, 2010, p.76).

The development of the 2.0 technologies enables librarians to embed themselves across all types of libraries. Academic librarians now co-teach with academic faculty member in both traditional and virtual classrooms. Furthermore, subject librarians inject subject – specific content by creating research guides via Springshare LibGuides technologies or social media networking technologies such as Facebook.

The end-user-driven innovation concept has been fully applied in the service delivery model of librarianship. Librarians are finding innovative ways to create new services and build relationships with people who need their services (Shumaker, 2009).







Article: Little Free Library in Malaysia: New concept to encourage people to read book



The Little Free library in Malaysia is a new approach to encourage more Malaysian to read books, especially among the youngster. This concept is really good for everybody to practice at home as this would help people especially those in the middle-income range, to buy leisure books to support and promote reading habit among Malaysian. Community members who have a vast collection of reading materials in their home can put them in a container in front of their house, offering their neighbourhood to lend it. This may also help those people who hardly go to public library to borrow books.

Originally, this concept was popularized in Hudson, Wisconsin, in 2009 when Todd Bol mounted a wooden container designed to look like a school house on a post on his lawn as a tribute to his mother, who was a book lover and a school teacher. Bol shared his idea with his partner, Rick Brooks, who spread the word, and the idea spread rapidly.

Then, in May 2012, Todd Bol of Hudson and Rick Brooks of UW-Madison officially established a non-profit organisation known as Little Free Library, which supports this project. Currently, there are about 36,000 Little Free Library book exchanges around the world, bringing curbside literacy home and sharing millions of books annually.

For a start, Library owners can create and design their own library container, usually about the size of a doll house. The container can be put in front of your house and you may put any phrases at the container such as "Take a Book. Leave a Book", "Knowledge Box" and many more based on your creativity, so that it will attract your neighbours to also share their books in the container. Besides lending the book, they also can leave their book in the container for exchange and be read by others.

In Malaysia, this concept has been implemented in the Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia (USIM) where the Library built 10 Little Free Library and put around the campus. There is another LFL that has been introduced for Nilai Impian community by Mrs Nor Azzah Momin.

Where can I get updates and latest notice/information on the library opening hours and such?

How about the overdue fines when I late return borrowed books?

Late return fine charges will be calculated as per below tabulation on the first 30 days after the item is overdue. However on the 31st day, the fine charges will automatically described as RM 50.00 and the subsequent days of late return after day 31, another RM 0.50/day will be charged respectively for all items except reference which will be charged RM1.00/day.



Can I return borrowed books to any MMU library?

The library which is situated at the Melaka campus was named University Telekom Library (UNITELE Library) and could only accommodate about 600 students during that time. The Multimedia University (MMU) Library was then moved to a new building in May 2000. In 1999, another MMU library was set up in Cyberjaya, Selangor, Malaysia and was given the name Siti Hasmah Digital Library. This library was launched on 24th July 2000 with the intention of it being first Academic University Digital Library for the nation.
