### IFLA WLIC 2018 – Kuala Lumpur

This year's IFLA World Library and Information Congress, IFLA WLIC 2018, along with the 84th IFLA General Conference and Assembly was held from 24 to 30 August in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

The theme of the Congress, Transform Libraries, Transform Societies, aimed to bring attention to the crucial role of libraries in the development and advancement of society as a whole, from a local, over national, to the global level. The Congress brought together more than 3,500 participants from over 110 countries who had the opportunity to take part in more than 250 open sessions, see 120 poster presentations and hear 600 speakers. Under the slogan Inform, Reform, Transform, the Congress's programme aimed to encourage learning, analyses of many aspects of library activity, professional debate and provided many inspirational examples of innovative library practices from across the world. As an international institution strongly promoting better social inclusion, IFLA streamed live selected parts of the congress programme which were followed by over 100,000 viewers from all parts of the world.

MMU librarians also participated in this event as national committee, full paid participants and volunteers. Two of our librarians have received grants from National Library of Malaysia to attend the conference. Siti Hasmah Digital Library is also one of the selected venue for library visit.

Organizing IFLA WLIC 2018 in Kuala Lumpur, is the best experienced that I could have in my entire librarianship career so far. I always treasure every moments and challenges to organize world class event.

The visit was scheduled on 30th of August and about 20 participants comprise of local and international librarian has come to experience the dynamism of MMU Library in providing information, resources and meaningful services to its users.

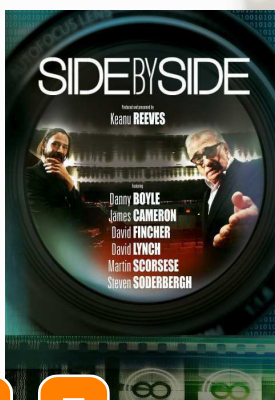
## Los Angeles Plays Itself

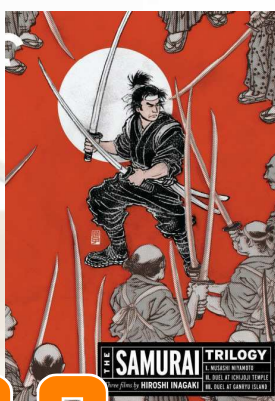

# WHAT IS CRITICAL WRITING?

Now, let's continue the article from the last issue about critical writing.

### Finding your academic voice:

When you engage in critical writing you are developing your own academic voice within your subject. Wellington et al. (2005, p.84) offer some suggestions for distinguishing between the academic and the non-academic voice. They suggest that the academic voice will involve:

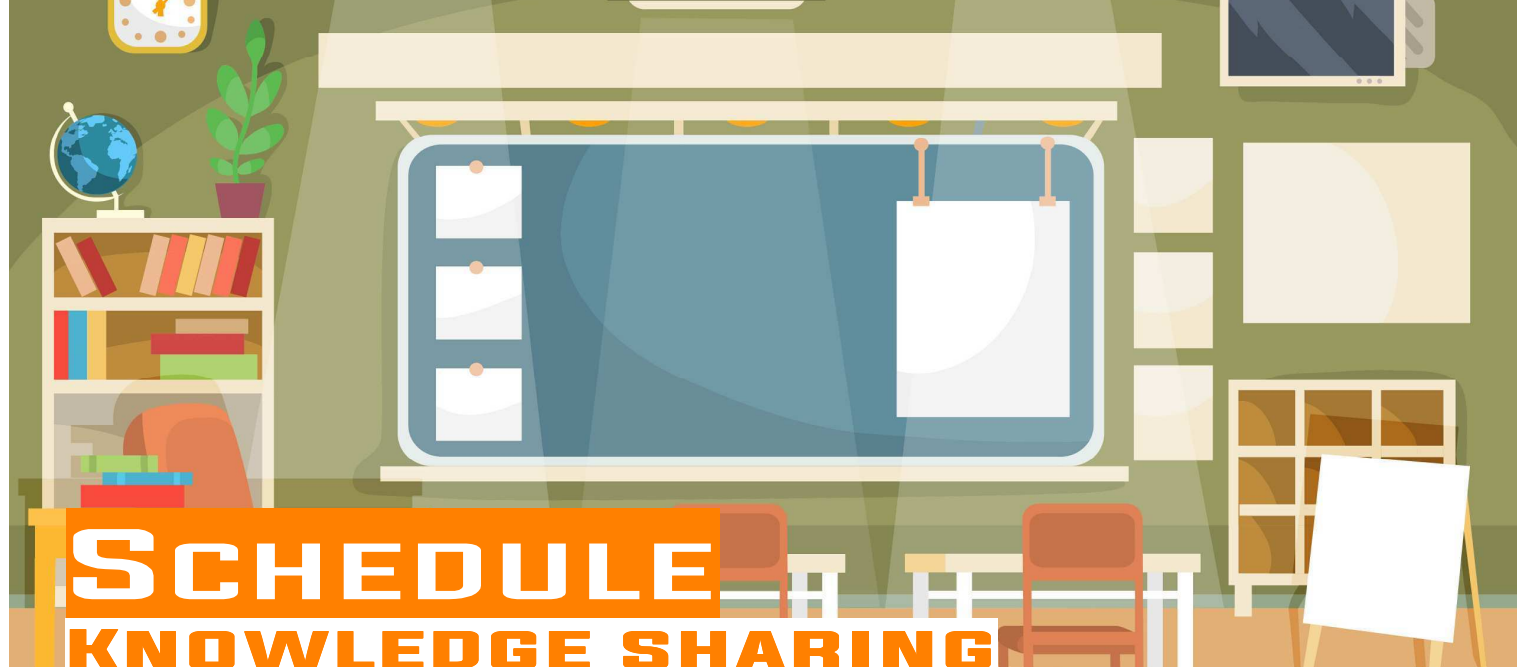
- “healthy scepticism ... but not cynicism;
- confidence ... but not ‘cockiness’ or arrogance;
- judgement which is critical ... but not dismissive;
- opinions ... without being opinionated;
- careful evaluation of published work ... not serial shooting at random targets;
- being ‘fair’: assessing fairly the strengths and weaknesses of other people’s ideas and writing ... without prejudice; and
- making judgements on the basis of considerable thought and all the available evidence ... as opposed to assertions without reason.”

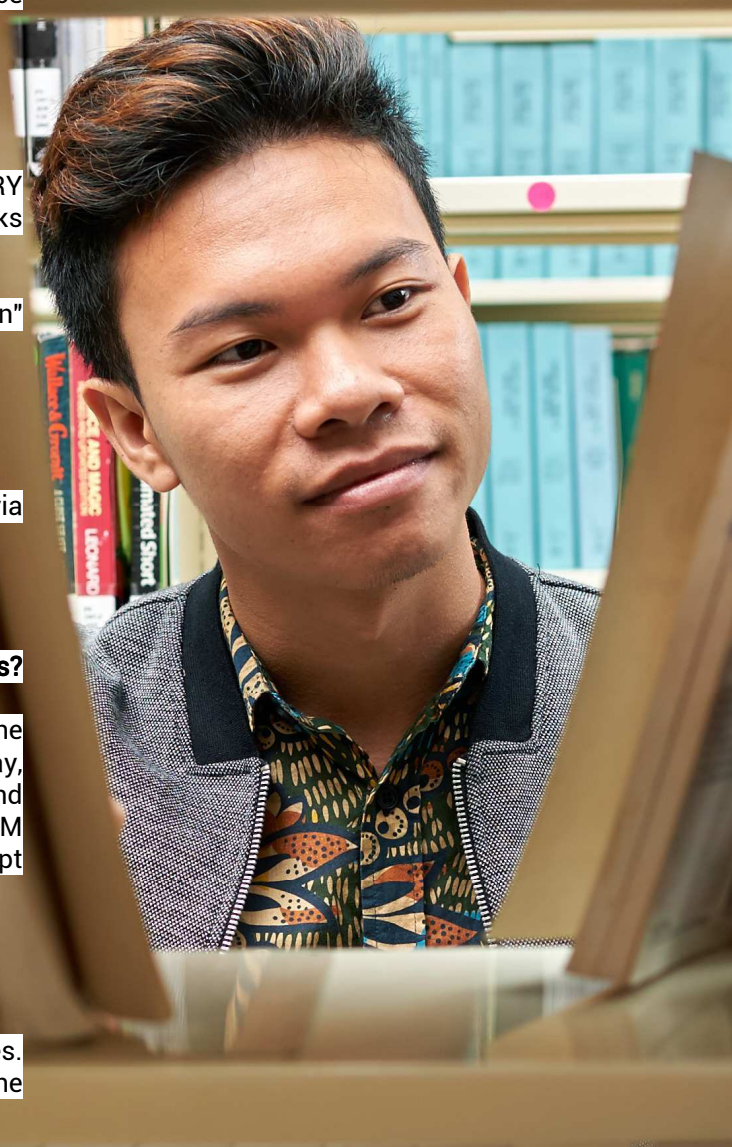
### **Can I return borrowed books to any MMU library?**
